CHALLENGES

Additionally, the scope for the digitalisation of HSE processes at both entity and corporate levels was explored, to leverage technology to enhance efficiency, monitoring, and reporting. This holistic approach provided a clear roadmap for improving legal compliance, operational effectiveness, safety performance, and long-term business continuity.
